Covid Re-launch Plan

Distancing Measures:

1. All people will be required to wear face masks when coming into the facility and while waiting for their class in the lobby. They will keep the masks on until they get to a chair where they can change into their clogging shoes.
2. The chairs will be spaced at least 2 metres apart.
3. When leaving or going to the washroom everyone will be required to wear a face mask.
4. During breaks all will be required to wear masks unless they are staying on their chairs.
5. Classes will be limited to a maximum of 18 cloggers on the dance floor. With the flooring we have that will give each dancer about 8ft X 10ft of space. That should have dancers stay at least 2 metres apart at any given time.

Cleaning:

1. While the city will be cleaning the facility, we will have hand sanitizer at the door and ask all to use it.
2. We will have Lysol wipes and Lysol spray available for anyone wanting to make sure a surface is clean.

Screening for Symptoms:

1. A list of symptoms will be given to all dancers.
2. Everyone will be required to assess themselves before they come and stay home if they have any symptoms or if they have been in contact with someone that has a positive test or suspected positive.
3. Attendance will be taken by the instructor. Should someone be positive we will have a list of all that were there.
4. If someone is positive in the class all in the class will be contacted via phone or e-mail.
5. Participants who are symptomatic WILL NOT attend any sessions.

Personal Protective Equipment:

1. All dancers will be required to wear face masks when distancing can't be done.
 - When entering the building
 - In the foyer waiting for class
 - In the hall until they are at their chair
 - During breaks or when going to the washroom
 - When leaving the hall/building

Responsibility to make sure all comply:

1. Almost all of the dancers are mature women. They will be told the rules and trusted to do what is asked. If someone doesn't comply they will be banned from the class.
2. There are a couple of children under 16. Their guardian will be asked to make sure they follow the procedures.
3. All dancers will be asked to anonymously report to an instructor or club executive if they see someone not complying.
4. A up-to-date list of club members is always maintained.

First Aid and Emergency Planning:

1. There will be a clogger that has first aid/CPR training present during classes. At present the instructor as well as a few cloggers have certification.
2. The club will have a first aid kit on hand at all times contain all standard first aid equipment as well as rubber gloves, clean medical grade face masks, hand sanitizer and Lysol wipes.
3. Dancers will be instructed that in case of an incident to please stand back and let the people with training tend to the person.
4. Should a participant develop covid symptoms while dancing, the participant should leave immediately. If waiting for a parent, the participant will be isolated from the remaining participants and arrangements with parents will be made to pick up the participant immediately.
 - Immediate isolation of the symptomatic participant from others, including arrangement for safe travel home (e.g., no public transit).
 - Club executive will consider whether future classes need to be cancelled.
 - Cleaning and disinfecting of all equipment and surfaces that may have come into contact with the symptomatic participant will be done.
 - All other people in the class will be instructed to thoroughly wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer.
